- Completed applications and all letters of recommendation must be mailed to Executive Director Lou Miller postmarked no later than **June 30, 2017**.
- The NJASC State Officers will review all applications and decide on the award winners at their September 2017 Executive meeting.
- The NJASC Advisor of the Year awards will be given at the Fall Business Meeting in October 2017. Each winner will be given the opportunity to briefly speak to those in attendance.
- The award winners will complete paperwork to be considered for the Region 2 and National Warren E. Shull Advisor of the Year awards by **November 15, 2017**.
