PROVIDE A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THIS PROJECT:

Every Friday, the Student Council has Spirit Days. Some Spirit Day examples would be Superhero Day, Western Day, Blackout Day, Crazy Hair Day, Sweatpants Day, Halloween Day, Tye Dye Day, Blast of the Past, etc. Every person that participates receives a Warrior Card. (A Warrior Card is something our school does, where you receive a little piece of paper from a teacher if you perform a good deed, get a good grade, or do something that a teacher feels deserves a reward. You fill out your name and why you received it, drop it in a bin in the office, and at the end of each month there is a warrior card drawing of 10 cards, each person receives a prize bag.) When January comes, we begin to count points for Clash of The Classes (See Clash Of The Classes page) For every person that participates is one point for their grade.

DESCRIBE THE PLANNING & EXECUTION OF THIS PROJECT:

A list of spirit days is determined by Student Council at the first few meetings of the year. Then the Vice President and President determine which spirit day applies to which Friday. All Spirit Days are approved by our principal.

Students get a chance to have fun and get credit for it.
