Spirit Week Activities-EXPLANATION

1. **Spirit spot** (plays on the morning show) Your grade should prepare a creative video clip that advertises or frames your grade's theme and enthusiasm for the week. It should be no longer than 1 minute. Your spirit spot should be school appropriate. If it contains any inappropriate references, the clip will be disqualified. **KHS STUDENTS SHOULD BE PRESENT IN THE VIDEO.**
2. **Hallway Decoration-** (Monday at 2:30) Each class will be assigned a hallway to decorate after school and are encouraged to spotlight the Spirit Week theme. This event will begin after school on Monday at 2:30 p.m. and must conclude by 4:00 p.m. You must plan ahead and purchase all the decorations for the hallway. You may not borrow any materials from the teachers. There are new guidelines for permissible decorations; violation will result in disqualification. Classes will be judged not only on the presentation and following guidelines but also on cleanup which will take place on Friday, October 22nd after school.
3. **Dress-up Day:** Dress up in the Spirit Week theme. Each grade will have one male and one female winner.
4. **Quiz Bowl-** (Tuesday during school)- 5 students from your grade will participate on the quiz bowl team. Each grade will be asked a question. The topics will include: Sports, pop culture, academics, and Kinnelon history. If they answer it correctly, they will get 1 point. If they do not know the answer, they can pass it on to another grade. The other team can either attempt to answer the question for a point, or dare the questioning team to a physical challenge. In a physical challenge, 4 previously selected students (2 boys and 2 girls set aside before the activity) participate in whatever challenge the student council says. The winning team gets 1 point. If there is a tie at the end, one tie-breaking question will decide a winner. A jeopardy smart board activity is used for this event.
5. **Volleyball-** 7 males and 7 females from each grade will compete. All are welcome. Wear sneakers. Takes place after school at 7 p.m.
6. **Dance Competition-** (Wednesday and Thursday night) Classes may determine number of participants (usually 40-50 participants), but note that male participation is one of the judging criteria. Each class will perform a dance to a sound/music mix. The dance itself will not exceed 10 minutes, with no more than five minutes permitted for set up or clean up. Dances should include sound judgment in taste as well as music selection. Some reference towards the theme is strongly encouraged, though other criteria will weigh heavily on judging. ****THE WINNING GRADE WILL PERFORM ON FRIDAY DURING COLOR DAY.
7. **Band Day-** (Thursday during school) Each grade will appoint a band, which consists of its students to put together an 8-minute performance showcasing the student's talent. The song or medley of songs should go along with your theme. Bands must set up their equipment at 6:30 am on the day of the competition and remove all equipment right after school. The school does not provide any equipment including extension cords. The performance cannot exceed 8 minutes, or disqualification will be put into place. Crowd participation is strongly suggested.
8. **Color Day-** (Friday during school-two blocks) Color day is a half day filled with many different activities, including relay races, tug of war, a pie eating contest, and many more. For each event, a certain amount of students from each grade can volunteer. He/she can participate in only **one** activity, excluding tug of war. Students are encouraged to wear their class colors.
9. **Color Day Colors-T-shirt designs:** In September, select an artist to design your t-shirt for the class. The advisors will find a company to create the t-shirts and the class officers will sell the t-shirts prior to Spirit Week. The students are judged on t-shirt design and the number of participants wearing the class colors on COLOR DAY.
10. **Banners-** Beginning at 2:30 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. on Friday, each grade will receive the supplies for the first time and be permitted to work on their banner. People working on the banner may leave the room only to trade supplies, but may not bring anything back into the room that was not part of the original list. The grade must also type a short description about their banner that will be read during the presentation of the banners. Supplies will be provided for you. On Thursday night, you will be emailed the theme that you must include in the banner with a quote that represents your category.
11. **Spirit Treats:** Each grade will have a day during the week to create snacks and desserts for the staff that represent their theme. Creativity is key in this event!
12. **Spirit Cans:** Each grade will have a designated area to drop off canned goods for those less fortunate. Students are encouraged to bring in canned goods throughout the week and write their grade number on the item (9, 10, 11, or 12). The student council will count the cans everyday and update the scores in the cafeteria. The class with the most cans WINS!
13. **Penny Wars:** Students will bring in bills and coins and put them in the water jugs. All the money goes to the classes and a portion of the money going to the student council. The class with the most positive score wins 40% of the money. Every other grade and the SC receive 15%.
14. **Anti-Bullying Day-** Students may purchase "Bullying Stops Here" t-shirts from the student council. All students and staff are encouraged to wear pink on Anti-bullying day to promote anti-bullying the school. The faculty will take a tally of all the students who wear pink on this day and the class with the most participants will receive 1st place., etc. Why pink? Check our website!
15. **Karaoke:** Each grade will select two or three students to participate in Karaoke.
16. **Pumpkin Carving (New event):** Carve pumpkins based on your theme. There will be more details to come. Gather individuals for the event. It will take place after-school on Thursday and they will be displayed on Sunday, October 28th at the "Push to Walk" event on the high school track on Sunday late afternoon. You can have as many people carve pumpkins but each class will vote for one pumpkin to be voted on in the final competition. The pumpkins will be provided for us and you must bring your own tools. You may bring in stencils/designs if desired.
