Things to consider before you start:

1. How many class periods are in a day at your school? Subsequently, how many passing times between classes are there?
2. Can your school's PA system be accessed by students, before, during, and after school hours?

You Will Want:

- A table which is:
 - in a hallway that is heavily passed through

- easily accessed by students
- able to be sufficiently monitored
- Three decorated boxes
- Three 8.5x11 display placards
- Many “on-deck” posters affixed with replaceable sleeves (*see demonstration*)
- CDs/Internet music downloading program

The Premise:

- Three boxes on the table at a chosen location in the school
- Each box represents a different song
- Students will “vote” for the song they most want to hear by putting any amount of money in its box
- A "voting" will happen during a passing time (i.e. between 2nd and 3rd period)
 - The song that received the most donations during this period will be played over the loudspeaker during the subsequent passing time (so, between 3rd and 4th period)
- This process will be repeated accordingly throughout the day and week
