- 1- I must attend ALL practices.  
(You may miss two, BUT you MUST get excused by us first. BUT, it may NOT be the week of the show.)
- 2- I must obtain a sponsor and a \$100 sponsor donation.

- 6- I must not exceed the limit of 12 unexcused absences from school.
- 7- I must keep my grades at a 65 and be eligible to graduate.  
(I realize that, as I sign this contract, if my grades are not at a 65 or above, I need to be at a 65 or above by the end of the second marking period, or I will be eliminated from the competition.)

If I fail to meet any of the criteria above, I am aware that my candidacy will be rescinded immediately and an alternate candidate will take my place.
