How to plan and organize event:

Schedule: (Based on this year's event)

September: Nomination survey with all of the categories must be sent out within the first month of school

September- October:

Students will be given two months to fill out the nomination survey. In the meantime, emails can be sent out asking for two main event hosts along with the category nominee presenters. These hosts must only be from the Junior Class

November: Top four nominees are counted from nomination survey and a multiple-choice survey will be sent out including the top four nominees. This survey determines the winners for the various categories.

November- December: Students will be given one month to fill out the final voting survey.

December: Final votes are tallied up

<u>December- January 15:</u> Filming/editing during homeroom for the event's nominee and winners video is completed. (Television Production Elective Classes edit and film the video). Emails are also sent out about performers in between categories. Some students from chorus, band, dance team, etc. usually like to perform

<u>January 12:</u> Dress Rehearsal (First run through) for main hosts and nominee presenters

<u>January 17:</u> Audition for Glammies Performers: Held for teachers/advisers to approve acts

January 19: Final Dress Rehearsal for all performers and hosts
