



STAR WARS GAME



Objective: To be the first team to knock down the other teams SPACEPORTS (Styrofoam pins). [Winning can also occur if all opposing players are hit with a direct thrown ball (in the air/no bouncing or rolling and not above shoulders)– not encouraged].

Procedures: Two teams will be divided equally on opposite sides of the center line. When a player is hit with the ball they come to the sideline and sit out. They can return to the game if someone on their team catches a ball in the air(no bounce). If a player throws a ball and someone on the other team catches it, then the thrower is out! After each game, the teams reset the spaceports and sit quietly on their baselines to begin the next game. Players are encouraged to be honest and try for the spaceports and not to focus on hitting players. Players are not out if hit above the shoulders (head shot). Spaceports accidentally knocked down by their own players cannot be reset!

Variations: *Teams can be divided by various methods.

*Adding balls to game

*Teams can get one throw to hit the backboard on the opposing teams side to get all of their players back in the game.

MATERIALS: 6 Styrofoam pins

6 foam balls (more or less depending on amount of players)
